October 22 – November 8, 2011

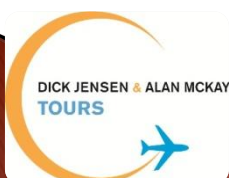


- October 22** – Depart from home city and fly to Los Angeles. Flight to New Zealand leaves at night.
